
IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

Read all instructions and save for future reference.

- Remove any stickers before using the citrus juicer.
- To protect against risk of electrical shock, do not put cord, plugs or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Fully unwind the power cord before use.
- Always make sure the citrus juicer is properly assembled before plugging in and using.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, or before cleaning.
- Avoid contacting moving parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions, or is dropped or damaged in any manner. Contact the customer service number listed in this manual.

PARTS LIST



BEFORE FIRST USE

- 1. Danger: Keep all packaging material away from children, there is a suffocation hazard.
- Remove any stickers before using the juicer for the first time and save any packaging material in the event the product must be returned for service.
- 3. Examine the juicer for visible damage and check that all of the parts are present.
- 4. Wash all removable parts before using it for the first time as instructed in the "Cleaning" section of this manual.
- 5. Wipe the motor base with a damp cloth.

OPFRATION

- 1. Place the appliance on an even surface that is easy to clean.
- 2. Connect the power plug to an AC120V, 60Hz electrical outlet.
- Choose the large or the small rotating head, depending on the type of fruit you are juicing.
- The large rotating head is suitable for juicing larger citrus fruit, such as grapefruits or oranges.
- 5. The small rotating head is suitable for juicing small citrus fruit, such as lemons or limes.
- If you wish to use the large rotating head, fit the small rotating head onto the drive shaft, and then place the large rotating head over the top of the small rotating head.
- 7. To separate the rotating heads, pull the large rotating head up and off.

Juicing:

Caution: if you apply too much pressure to the juicing rotating head, the motor may stop or seize.

- 1. Fit the appropriate rotating head onto the drive shaft.
 - a). If you wish to collect the juice in the container, press the spout upwards to close it (it will "snap" into place). A maximum of 12 oz. of juice can be held in the juice container.
 - b). If you want the juice to run straight into a cup, press the spout downwards to open it and then place a cup directly under the spout.
- 2. Plug the Juicer power cord into an easily accessible electrical socket.
- 3. Cut a citrus fruit in half and press the cut end of one fruit half onto the rotating head. The juicer switches on automatically when you press the handle down and the rotating head starts to turn. The juicer automatically switches off as soon as you reduce pressure on the rotating head. The rotating head scrapes the pulp out and squeezes the juice from the fruit. The juice flows through the strainer into the juice container from where it can either accumulate in the container or run directly into a cup. The strainer keeps back thick pulp and seeds.
- 4. To maximize the quantity of juice extracted from a fruit, press the fruit onto the rotating head several times.

AFTER USE

- 1. Unplug the appliance.
- Remove the rotating heads, strainer, juice container and drive shaft from the appliance and clean them as described in the "Cleaning" section of this manual.

JUICING ADVICE

- 1. Citrus fruit juices should be consumed immediately and never stored in a metal container.
- Citrus juices are ideal for mixing. For example, you can mix orange juice with lemon juice for extra vitamin C.
- Freshly squeezed juice gives cocktails a particularly tangy twist and better flavor. Lemon juice is also delicious in hot tea and additionally helps you build up your defenses when you have a cold.

CLEANING

- 1. Always unplug the unit before cleaning or when not in use.
- 2. Pull up on rotating heads to remove from strainer.
- 3. Remove the strainer from the pulp container.
- 4. Lift pulp container off of spindle.
- 5. Rinse the strainer, pulp container and rotating heads immediately after each use. Use a bristle brush to remove fine pulp that may remain.
- Use dish soap and warm water to wash all removable parts or place in the dishwasher, top rack only.
- Wipe the base with a damp cloth or sponge. Do not immerse in water or place in the dishwasher.

TROUBLE SHOOTING

- 1. Motor won't start Is the juicers power cord connected properly to the power outlet?
- 2. Motor stops running while juicing Do not apply too much pressure to the handle while juicing.
- 3. Although the spout is closed, juice still drips out Check to make sure bits of pulp are not keeping the spout from closing properly.
